## **English Faculty Position:**

Marianapolis Preparatory School seeks a qualified teacher, preferably with three to five years of experience in an independent secondary school setting, to teach English at both the advanced and entry levels, with the collaboration and supervision of the English Department Chair. This is a full-time position. An undergraduate degree in English or a related field is necessary. In addition, the school seeks a candidate who has knowledge and experience in using educational technology in the classroom. ClearTouch Technology is utilized to facilitate multimodal instruction. The ideal candidate will have:

- experience teaching high school level English with an ability to teach a range of levels and topics including, but not limited to, American and British literature, creative writing, and non-fiction
- a focus on cultivating dynamic writers and thinkers
- knowledge and experience in using educational technology in the teaching of English literature and writing
- demonstrable skills in oral and written communication
- skill at managing multi-faceted work in an active and supportive learning community
- a commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion in the classroom

In addition, the full-time position includes advising, participation as an athletic coach or activities leader for two seasons each year, and involvement in residential life — understanding that the typical commitment involves both after school activities and weeknight-weekend supervision.

All teacher candidates are expected to have either experience or interest in learning the *Understanding by Design* curriculum development framework. Preferred candidates must enjoy working with adolescents, have an ability to work well in a student-centered curriculum, and understand student learning styles and differentiated instruction.
